Overview

Sustainability Awareness Week was organized from **24 to 29 August 2026** across all boys' and girls' hostels of TIET to sensitize students towards the importance of environmental sustainability and responsible resource management. The initiative focused on encouraging students to incorporate sustainable practices into their daily lives and contribute towards creating a greener and more sustainable campus.

Key Activities

- The Sustainability team visited **all hostels** and conducted interactive awareness sessions with students and hostel executive committees.
- Students were sensitized about **energy conservation**, including responsible use of electricity, air conditioners, lights, fans, and other electrical appliances.
- Discussions were held on **water conservation** and the importance of avoiding unnecessary wastage of water in hostel facilities.
- Awareness was created regarding **proper waste segregation, recycling, and reduction of single-use materials**.
- Students were encouraged to maintain clean surroundings and actively participate in campus sustainability initiatives.
- The sessions also highlighted the importance of **individual responsibility and collective action** in addressing environmental challenges.
- Students were motivated to adopt simple sustainable habits such as switching off electrical appliances when not in use, reducing water wastage, minimizing waste generation, and promoting reuse and recycling.
